Wise Leadership in the church

They are vacating their positions, however they may be open to serving once again, if nominated.

We therefore are asking any and all of our church attenders to nominate potential men or women of any age, who they feel have the following qualities:

1. Spiritual Maturity
2. Commitment to the church by regular attendance and regular giving
3. Willingness to serve as a Board member.
4. Passionate about our Vision and Values.

What is spiritual maturity?

Spiritual maturity is simple really - it is the increasing ability to hear God (in a variety of ways) and to obey Him without delay. A spiritually mature person puts their faith into action, regardless of the circumstances. They do not live life according to their own desires/ thoughts etc, but rather seek God's will/law and, with humble recognition that His way is better than their way, they seek to be His disciple.

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths." (Proverbs 3:5-6, NKJV)
